

**Title:** Entre Dos Aguas

**Composer:** Paco De Lucia

**Style:** Rumba Flamenca

**Key:** A Dorian

**Time:** 3 - 3 - 2

**About:** Notes: Written in 1973, it was the first single on the album Fuente y caudal. Paco's brother is playing the second guitar and includes bongo and bass guitar. It sold 300,000 copies and catapulted Paco's career. Since its inception, Entre dos Aguas is considered a masterpiece of flamenco, is the most popular and well-known song of the artist, both nationally and internationally.

**Notes:** Am 7 – Bm7- Am7 – B7 (b9)  
Use the A Dorian Scale to solo over this using the notes  
A – B – C – D –E – F# – G – A  
Some changes in position required  
Keep a slight accent on the 1st beat  
Use slurs as needed.  
watch your tempo in faster passages  
use rest stroke or picado for melody
